


Stream API plug-in for Drupal

Free CMS plug-ins

Currently, free plug-ins are available for WordPress and Drupal. You are welcome to install, test, use and if needed modify these plug-ins. Both plug-ins can be set to work in our test environment (Sandbox) or to real production mode.

As a developer, you are of course welcome to develop your own solutions, either by modifying the plug-ins we offer or by creating your own based on the Stream API interface.



You will need to create new client for testing in sandbox mode as well as new real client in production mode later. Please visit <http://www.idioma.com/en-GB/partners/for-developers/> to create your own sandbox account. You will receive the client's credentials to provided email.



How to develop with idioma

- 
Create Sandbox account and obtain:
 - API access with an API Key and an API Secret.
 - An idioma test account, so you can develop calls from your system to your idioma account to query the system for delivery terms, prices, etc.
 - Access to our Dummy Translation Server that accepts text from your system, and returns dummy translations (same text with initial letters in each word replaced).[CREATE YOUR SANDBOX ACCOUNT NOW](#)
- 
Get our Dev Tools
 - Including a demo download, detailed descriptions of all API calls and responses, and the "localization lifecycle" that shows you in which order calls must be made.
 - Adjust the API as desired.
 - Once you have developed your own "lifecycle" and you are certain the full circle works for you, you are ready for the final step.[GET DEV TOOLS AND DOCUMENTATION](#)

Upgrade to Full Status and GO LIVE!
 - Switch your Sandbox account to Live status
 - Get Live account access and an additional set of Live API keys for each unique client your system supports.

Your app or site is now ready for being published in numerous different languages.

If you want to use the plug-in in production mode and order real translations for your web, you will need the free upgrade to full status first. In this step you will acquire partner status with idioma and access to idioma portal as new agent for your own client(s).



There is a new section “Idioma translate” under *Configuration > Regional and Language* after *Stream API* plug-in installation.



The Idioma translate module has one tab for “Carts” management, other tab for “Settings” and one for the “Authentication”.



First, when you select the Idioma translate, you will be asked to link the module to your idioma’s account. Log in with your client’s credentials to idioma portal when asked and your account will be linked with the Idioma translate module.



The Idioma translate module is set to Sandbox mode as default. You can test the functionality of the module, while there is no real translation provided. This mode is free of charge.

The Sandbox mode can be changed to Production mode in the Settings tab of the Idioma translate module.

Please be sure to set up basic information in the Settings. After the Work mode selection, you are able to select Default language of your pages. Then you should select the target languages for your translations from the list “Automatically add language mapping” and confirm the selection with “Add language” button.





“Estimate” action will send the cart to idioma servers to generate the word count and price offer.

“View” option will show the detailed content and the setup of the selected cart.

With “Delete” option, you are able to remove the cart completely. Please note that Delete option is available only until you order the cart.

When the estimation is finished, you are able to see the price and download the PDF with detailed offer.


The “Order” action will appear now and you can send the cart to be translated for the offered price.





Multiple content translation and partial delivery of the translation

With multiple content in one cart you are able to delete (or import, which is depending on cart's status) selected items or cancel all items of one selected language from the cart details.



Please note that canceling a language in a running translation process could generate adequate costs. Cancel the language before the translation order.

Partially delivered translation can be imported and processed for proofreading. This may help with large projects, where some of languages can be finished earlier than others.
